This is a role-play scenario in which you are a Product Manager at SourceFuse. You have a client in the EdTech industry and they are looking for a new application that will provide virtual course guidance for US-based public Universities and Colleges.

Please review the details of the application requirements below. Your task is to then provide 3 - 5 clickable wireframes depicting the flow of requirements with accompanying feature write-ups. You can use any tool of your choice e.g. Lucidchart/Balsamiq/etc.

This is an exercise to assess your...

- Ability to document requirements
- Ability to translate requirements into mockups / wireframes
- Attention to detail and general resourcefulness

Application Information

Your client is creating an EdTech application that will allow US-based colleges and universities to provide virtual advisement to current and prospective students based on their desired major(s) and minor(s) and courses completed to date. The application should integrate with the institution's existing course management system.

Existing students should be able to view the courses they have completed or have in progress and view the remaining courses they have to meet their assigned major or minor requirements. If they do not have a defined major or minor, they should be able to find potential majors and minors based on courses completed to date. Existing students can also indicate careers of interest and the application should recommend additional majors and minors based on courses completed to date. The application will indicate what courses the student must complete in order to graduate with the selected major and/or minor.

Prospective students should be able to indicate careers of interest and the application should recommend major and minor combinations. The student should be able to select a major and/or minor combination and receive a course list by entering their email address.

Based on the above requirements, please create 3-5 wireframes with corresponding feature write-ups.
